**Denture-related oral pathology**

Dr Elishka Marvan, BDS. MDS. Grad. Dip. Psychology, Registered Specialist in Oral Medicine will present this much demanded session.

There are many patients who have their dentures made by a dental prosthetist rather than a dentist. The prosthetist is therefore in the best position to identify the presence of oral lesions that may be asymptomatic, and thus unnoticed by the patient. Some of these lesions may be directly related to the presence of a denture, for example denture-induced hyperplasia, while other conditions may be aggravated by a denture, for example mucous membrane pemphigoid, a dermatological condition. This presentation will cover lesions that may be pre-existing, and require investigation and management prior to having a denture made, and lesions which can occur once a patient has had a denture inserted. The aim of the lecture is to highlight the various clinical presentations of intraoral lesions so that the dental prosthetist can identify these lesions and refer the patient appropriately.
