Introduction to Computers and the internet - 1¼ non- scientific hours  
- The relevance to Dental Prosthetists

Presented by Paul Werner, a Dental Prosthetist and an Internet Service Provider

Paul has participated on numerous political deputations to promote the scope of Dental Prosthetists. As past Vice President and Treasurer of the Association, he has participated on Committees, such as the RMIT Education Advisory and Victorian Denture Scheme committees. During the past 10 years, Paul has been involved in computer applications in various health related practices and also heads a company providing Internet Services throughout Australia. He is a member of the Internet Industry Association.

Paul's presentation will focus on why would you need a computer?, PC's versus Laptops; computer application for Dental Prosthetists and how to use the internet, especially in relation to accessing information required for infection control regulations and the Dental Practice Board of Victoria.

New Technology from Canada- (1¼ non-scientific hour)

Presented by Frank Dionisi and Sue Neely on new software from Canada, currently "up and running" at Daniel Kutny's Practice in Melton.

Canada went through a technology revolution, regarding keeping accurate records of patient histories, approximately 10 years ago, when the Bridge Network developed "Tracker for Denturists" as a solution for record keeping.

"Tracker for Denturists" is a, complete practice management system that was originally designed specifically for denturists. It was the first Windows-based dental practice management system developed in Canada.

Frank, attending from The Bridge Network, Inc. Canada, and Sue, who implemented the system for Daniel Kutny, will give an overview of the system as an example of what technology can do for you today.
