The Session held on 18<sup>th</sup> May on “Achieving perfect fit, form and function” by Professor Bickel, was so successful that we have decided to follow that evening’s format. Work first, then some time to socialise with your colleagues over finger food and a drink.

This new session will suit all Dental Prosthetists, a little on a new product and then some tips for some sound Insurance risk advice.

#### **New Product – VERSACRYL (1¼ hours scientific)**

VERSACRYL is a heat-sensitive, multi-purpose acrylic.

This acrylic can create any part of a denture to become adjustable, simply by using warm water. It can be extended, for example, into any undercut to mechanically retain a denture; it can be used to produce repeatable thermo-relines; it can replace metal clasps on partials; it can create sublingual wings to stabilize lower dentures, etc. As a unique feature, the consistency of VERSACRYL is pre-determined during its mixing stage and has a controllable range from hard to soft. This allows the creation of an infinite range of consistencies: from very soft while heated, to as hard as denture base.

It is a versatile new generation acrylic used in creating clear or pink thermo-elastic denture clasps, gaskets, add-ons, lingual flanges, and relines.
